

# Training on Early Infant Diagnosis (EID) Data Collection and Data Entry in ART Database

June 20-21, 2024, Sokha New York Hotel, Kampong Chhnang province

The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD (NCHADS) is conducting a refresher training on Early Infant Diagnosis (EID) data collection and data entry in ART database in Kampong Chhnang province with financial support by Global Fund Fighting for AIDS, Malaria and Tuberculosis (GFAMT).



This training aims to provide update on EID service provision, refresh and instruct on EID data entry, and discuss to identify the challenges in EID data collection and testing. Based on National HIV Estimates 2022, Cambodia is facing gap of HIV cascade among children living with HIV/AI

DS. So, this training is expected to identify problem and prepare corrective plan for improving program.

The participants of this training are EID service providers and data entry clerks at ART services from 14 provinces including Battambang, Banteay Meanchey, Pursat, Kampong Thom, Kratie, Kep, Pailin, Preah Vihear, Stung Treng, Rattanakiri, Kampot, Tbong Khmum, Siem Reap and Oddar Meanchey totally 41 participants.

The training was official opening announced by **Dr. Samreth Sovannarith**, deputy director of NCHADS and followed by the technical session from national facilitators and technical assistance from EpiC project of FHI 360.
